The Ponies Make Their Own Show in Chantilly!

Every day during the February holidays (17th February to 12th March), the Easter holidays (7th April to 2nd May), All Saints (29th October to 8th November) and every Wednesday and Saturday throughout the year, at 2.45 p.m., our youngest visitors are invited to the Living Museum of the Horse for a special show: “The Ponies Make Their Own Show”.

The heroes of this performance are called Ramsès le Grand, Moustique, Champion, Louki or Ortzi. They may be tiny but they have a character to be reckoned with! For 25 minutes, along with Little Harlequin, they offer the youngest visitors the chance to get to know them better.
